AM and **PM**

There are 24 hours in one day, but the day can be measured by splitting it into two halves. The first 12 hours of the day - from midnight to midday - are called AM, and the next twelve hours are called PM.

Analogue and Digital (24hour clock)

On the **analogue clock**, the time is represented by hands that spin around a dial and point to a location on the dial that represents the approximate time. On a **digital clock**, a numeric display indicates the exact time. Therefore, digital time will be written using 4 digits, separating hours and minutes with a colon. E.g ten past two in the morning is written as 02:10 and ten past two in the afternoon is written as 14:10
