Good morning,

Following the NI Executive announcement regarding school closure please be advised of the following:

- **school will remain closed to most pupils until Monday 22 February** (week of 15 Feb is planned midterm week)
- throughout this time your child's teacher will be teaching remotely **every day** – work should be completed and returned to your child's teacher via SEESAW
- home learning tasks will include Literacy, Numeracy, Reading, World Around Us, PE, Art, Religion
- **packs will be provided for all of the children and will be distributed this Friday 8 January** as per the schedule attached – please adhere to the times stated and only **ONE person should come to collect the pack to reduce numbers at the school – SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE OBSERVED AND A MASK WORN IN ORDER TO GAIN ENTRANCE TO THE SCHOOL GROUNDS**
- **if you or any member of your household is isolating or experiencing any symptoms of COVID you must not attend** – email [fkeegan344@c2kni.net](mailto:fkeegan344@c2kni.net) and we will make alternative arrangements
- those children who receive additional support in school will receive work from their support teacher also
- we are sending home work for 3 weeks initially and will then provide further work as we do not want to overwhelm you or your child
